let us bring an end to fear and danger:

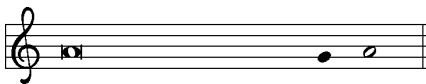

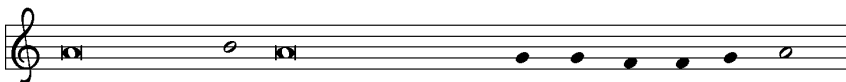
