as you have welcomed us.**

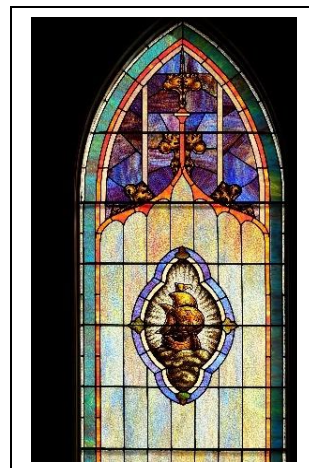
We sin in thought, word, and deed.

PROFESSION OF FAITH

In the night in which he was betrayed,
