Pastor's Thoughts for February

Isaiah 64:8 Yet, O LORD, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter; we are all the work of your hand.

Have any of you ever created a meal and said, "This dish needs a little something!" Then you add some salt or pepper or cinnamon to create an interesting or more flavor-filled taste. It seems to me that God our creator does the same thing. God is an artist that loves to create. But God isn't interested in producing identical people like widgets from a factory. God has a bigger idea in mind. God looks at the created being and says, "This person needs a little something special. I'm going to add a sense of humor or leadership ability or skill with financial details or people management." It is consistent with God's love for the world that this person exercise these traits in ways that benefit a family, a business or a community of faith.

When someone creates a meal there are different parts to the meal. All the parts, while individual, combine to create a pleasing total meal from salad to soup to bread to meat to vegetables to dessert. A clever chef chooses the individual parts to complement each other. When God creates a faith community God draws in individuals who add flavor to the mix. Those individuals have talents, skills, and abilities that generally complement each other.

In the 1964 television classic Rudolph the Red-nosed reindeer, the characters were afraid of the abominable snowman and didn't think he had a place in their community. That is, until Yukon Cornelius showed them that the snowman was uniquely created to place the star on the top of the Christmas tree. He may have had only one job but it was an important one!

God is the potter and we are the clay. We are the work of God's hands. God added characteristics to our personality that make us unique while also shaping us to have a place in God's community. It was with joyful intent that God created each of us and we can give thanks for God's creative ability.

 - b. Ali Peters can't find any insurance companies that will insure Vasa. She pursued one lead that would insure Vasa for \$70,000/yr. Once outstanding claims are finished we should have better results.
 - c. We will begin to train people in a few people with the finances for back up reasons.
 - d. Finance team recommended a two percent increase in pay for office staff. This wouldn't include Kathy or lawn mowing. A vote will be held at next month's meeting.
- 3. Parish Life (Attached)
 - a. 2022 budget will be very close to what 2021 was.
 - b. Sunday school has been working very well at Lutheran Center with one Sunday a month for intergenerational worship.
- 4. Property Team Report (Attached)
 - a. We received an estimate from David Grandall for work to be done on the organ. It would be anywhere between \$5,000 and \$10,000. We would have to put a down deposit of fifty percent to get on the schedule for 2025 at the earliest.
